History of the German Riding Pony

The German Riding Pony breed or *Deutsches Reitpony* developed approximately 40 years ago. The breeding goal was to develop a pony with movement that is correct and rhythmic with elastic and expressive gaits as well as having a pony with a sound temperament and rideability. A very important component is that the pony has the athletic ability for national and international competition and that they could be easily ridden by a child or small adult in the performance arena.

Using the same principles as Warmblood horses, the German Riding Pony breeding program began with imported Welsh and English ponies to be bred with various breeds of European ponies. They were infused over time with Arabians and Thoroughbreds. Trakehner and Hanoverian sires were also used to improve the breed. The end result has shown that these ponies have become very competitive in the fields of dressage, eventing, jumping and driving. They have the willingness to perform and dynamic movement to match.

The ultimate breed goal for these ponies is to meet the international height of 148 cms or under but like some of our Australian pony breeds, they can grow over pony height. They are still considered to be a German Riding Pony if they do go over pony height. Their background and genetics are of pony height and crossed with right pony mare with the correct genetics they can still produce a fabulous German Riding Pony.

In Germany, there are many over height GRP's that compete successfully and make fantastic mounts for small adults. A fine example of this is the GRP stallion *Pearcy Pearson* who stands at 152cm and has been very successful at Grand Prix. He actually gained a 5th place in a Grand Prix test that was won by Anky Van Grunsven.

Don Philino's lines boast the Hanoverian sire Lungau, who has produced an abundance of competition horses in Germany, including the international dressage horses Leonardo and Dugal. Lungau also presents in the lines of Anky Van Grunsven's 'Salinero'. Don Philino's blood lines also stem back to the famous welsh line Downlands.

Don Philino's sire **Dressman 1** was a very successful dressage pony and was the first pony ever to win the prestigious Bundeschampionate four years running.

Dressman 1 was the winner of the European Dressage championships, three times German Pony Champion and the winner of his stallion licensing and 30 day test. He has over 30 licensed sons and 20 state premium mares. Dressman 1 is known for making his offspring extremely rideable, which is a quality that Don Philino has inherited with abundance.

Don Philino's dam, state premium mare **Philine**, produced among others, the mare Philina who was champion of the county show in Aurich-Thannhausen 2007 and qualified for the Bundeschampionate and the elite mare show in Weser-Ems, all at the age of three.

He continued his success in 2009 and placed in every Elementary test that he competed in. Don Philino had performed in an enormous amount of competitions and various disciplines for a horse his age.

During 2010 we decided to consolidate his work at home, with the exception of travelling to Equitana 2010 in Melbourne. Don Philino earned himself many more fans after his Equitana trip.

Don Philino had his first Open Medium level dressage start at the Yalambi Dressage Classic in the South Western Town of Margaret River in 2011. He was awarded a 3rd and a 5th place. At the State Dressage Championships, Don Philino earned himself a 5th in a large strong field of Medium horses. Towards the end of the 2011 dressage season he placed 2nd and 5th in Open Medium dressage at the FoSEC Dressage Challenge at the State Equestrian Centre.

In 2012 Don Philino made his first start at Open Advanced level. He continued to gain places in both open Medium and Advanced Dressage throughout the year.

Don Philino had an outstanding performance record in Germany. He was champion of his 30 day stallion performance test in Neustadt Dosse with a dream overall score of 8.77. This made Don Philino a Premium stallion and this is still among the highest 30 day test scores for German Riding Ponies.

In 2005 he was awarded Reserve Bundeschampion of the 3 year old Dressage Ponies. The Bundeschampionate is a very prestigious German National event for young horses and ponies, for which they need to qualify in order to compete.

In 2006 he placed 7th in the dressage division of the Bundeschampionate and was the overall Bundeschampion of the Carriage Driving Ponies which is a great tribute to his character. In 2007 he qualified again for the driving division of the Bundeschampionate with a score of 9 and also qualified for the dressage section with a score of 8.2, He placed 8th in the finals and was ridden by a 14 year old girl. Don Philino also placed in several open dressage tests against warmbloods and has wins and places in jumping classes and other young horse classes during his competition career in Germany.

Since Don Philino arrived in Perth in January 2008 he has performed at several public displays and proven that he has a fantastic temperament and rideability. He was chosen to perform in a Masterclass with Micheal Schmidt and Janina Kletke of Germany. Janina, who was the bereiter for Carola Koppelman chose Don Philino as the one horse she would ride in the Masterclass. Michael and Janina were most impressed with Don Philino's rideability and movement and commented that he was a top class stallion.

Don Philino competed in his first dressage test in Australia at the Swan Valley Dressage Association competition in November 2008 and won the open Elementary.

He was selected to perform in the Christoph Hess Masterclass in November 2008 with Christoph commenting during the Masterclass that Don Philino could be a top dressage horse for WA and possibly in Australia.



At the Serpentine Dressage Series Finals he placed 2nd in the Advanced and 3rd in the Medium. At the Finals of the Swan River Dressage held at Brookleigh Estate he placed 3rd in the Advanced. Don Philino also placed 3rd in the Medium at the State Championships.

In 2013 Don Philino has placed in all his Open Advanced tests to date with a 3rd at the DAWA Dressage Championship Day and a 4th place at the SEC ACRES dressage. At the Serpentine Dressage Jill Stanton Memorial Dressage, Don Philino placed 1st and 2nd in the Open Advanced tests.

In his training at FEI level, he has a real talent in passage and piaffe and he really enjoys it. In 2013 he was being prepared to compete at PSG and Inter I when we noticed that there was a problem with Don Philino. The sad news for the team at Dynamik Stallions was that our super foundation stallion, has been diagnosed with Equine Recurrent Uveitis. All indications and advice pointed to him becoming blind over time.

The Veterinary Eye Specialist has confirmed that this is not in any way a genetic condition and is not a condition that he can pass onto his foals. The two veterinary specialists that work with Don Philino feel **that the likely cause of the ERU in Don Philino's case was that he was over vaccinated before import to Australia.** He was purchased in Germany at the time Equine Influenza broke out in Australia and Australian Quarantine stated that horses had to receive three extra EI vaccinations three weeks apart in order to be allowed into the country. He had already been fully vaccinated before being given the extra vaccines which then sent his immune system into a spin and potentially caused the immune mediated disorder ERU which has now sent him completely blind.

We are devastated by this turn of events as I was looking forward to starting Don Philino at FEI. His training has been sensational and his piaffe and passage had really developed. He tries and tries, even though for some time he must have been in quite a bit of pain and worried with his perceived changes in his environment. He was still winning and placing at Advanced level dressage in Open classes despite losing a lot of his vision.

Just a few weeks after losing his vision completely, and only a week after having surgery, Don Philino allowed me to present him in hand on the lunge at our 2014 Dynamik Stallions Open Day and there was not a dry eye in the crowd. He was truly amazing and presented himself as a proud stallion with the most outstanding character.

Still, we are glad to have this beautiful boy in our stables and his excellent character is a credit to him with his ability to cope as a blind breeding stallion. Due to further complications from this immune mediated disorder and the surgeries he has undergone as a result, he has been completely retired from being ridden as of early 2015.

Don Philino's four year old son, 'Don Peppino' (Don Philino/ Diskus) not only qualified for the Bundeschampionate 2011, he became a finalist. He has inherited his sire's amazing temperament and movement. He scored a 9.5 for his walk in the first round, with a total score of 8.33 to gain himself a place in the finals where he placed equal seventh. This is a really great tribute to Don Philino as a sire.

Don Philino's Australian Progeny are also having success in the Breed Shows with many his youngsters winning Champions and Reserve Champion titles.

His progeny in both Germany and Australia are proving themselves to be easily ridden by children and small adults. It is very exciting that there are young Don Philino progeny under saddle in Australia. Owners in both Australia and Germany report that his progeny have exceptional temperaments and present at their first outing as if they have been out many time before. His progeny in Australia have already had success with wins and places in show hunter, eventing, dressage and pony club. His son was the 2014 Pony Champion of Champions at the Autumn Dressage Festival in WA and at the same show he had another son who placed 4th in the strong competitive Open Preliminary Dressage Classes.

A junior rider was awarded the highest percentage test score of all Junior Riders at the 2015 WA State Dressage Championships on board a son of our very only Don Philino. The success of his progeny has continued through 2015 with many having great success in all disciplines. They are all renowned for being easily ridden by children, even as green breakers. A son qualified and placed at the 2015 Dressage Festival (Victorian State Championships) and who has now qualified for the 2016 Dressage With The Stars (Australian Young Horse/Pony Championships). His progeny in both Australia and Germany have achieved outstanding successes.

Don Philino carries the sabino gene which can help foals inherit more bling. He has been successfully crossed with pony and warmblood mares and he passes on his compact and excellent pony type. He has also been successfully crossed with Thoroughbred mares to produce a compact and more leggy version of himself.

Top Der Da's sire is **FS Don't Worry** who is one of Germany's most outstanding pony sires.

FS Don't Worry is considered to be the 'Donnerhall' of the German Riding Ponies and has many outstanding progeny in Germany who have been very successful competition ponies.

FS Don't Worry won Bundeschampion two years running, receiving six scores of the perfect 10.

FS Don't Worry continued to be successful in his dressage career with multiple wins at Medium, Advanced, Prix St George and Inter I classes.

Top Der Da's Dam is **Daria** by Dressman 1 (who is the sire of Don Philino).

He himself won the prestigious Bundeschampionate four years running and was the winner of the European Dressage Championships three times German pony champion.

Daria also has the Bundeschampion sire Nantano in her bloodlines.

Top Der Da was licensed in 2008 in Muenster-Handorf for the Registry of Westphalia. His overall score was 75%.

Top Der Da's translates to "Top This One" and he is indeed hard to top with his combination of fantastic rideability and movement.

As a 3 year old, Top Der Da competed in three competitions in Germany. His first competition was in Seppenrade in open dressage with warmbloods where he placed 4th scoring 79.2%. He was the winner of the German Riding Pony Young Horse Dressage class and was the overall Champion of the day scoring 80.8%.

He competed in the young horse dressage class at Duermen Show against warmbloods and placed 3rd.

Top Der Da grew over pony height quite early and was therefore was unable to compete at his Bundeschampionate qualifier. He stood at stud for one season in Germany and was very popular with the breeders because of his modern type, exceptional power from behind and the outstanding combination of pedigree with FS Don't Worry and Dressman 1.

Dynamik Stallions purchased Top Der Da as a 3 year old following the trial riding of many stallions. The feeling that he gave under saddle showed he had the potential to be very competitive in dressage. He arrived in Perth in late December 2009, straight into our very hot summer.

Top Der Da's first show in Australia was at the Dressage Association of WA Gala Dressage Day in May 2010 where he placed 4th in an open Preliminary dressage test. He was an absolute gentleman at the show and coped well with the extremely waterlogged arena.

He competed at the Orange Grove Indoor Championship Qualifier placing third. In September 2010 Top Der Da competed at the SVDA competition for a 1st place with 70% and 2nd placing in his other test only beaten by an imported warmblood stallion.



Dynamik Stallions then traveled Top Der Da and his stable mate Don Philino to the Yalambi Dressage Classic in April 2011. This is a top class dressage event in Perth's South West town of Margaret River. Top Der Da gained two first places and an equal first with all three scores over 71%. He performed beautifully and was an absolute pleasure to ride. He was the overall Preliminary Open Champion. There is a Youtube clip of Top Der Da and the highlights from this show, including winning a massive warmblood sized rug in his presentation.

At the State Dressage Championships in April 2011, Top Der Da competed for the final time at Preliminary Level in a large, strong field of horses and gained a fourth place.

Top Der Da finished off the 2011 season with another Champion title and was invited as a Top 10 finalist for the year to the FoSEC Dressage Challenge Finals in Open Preliminary Dressage. He performed superbly and was awarded the Champion Preliminary Horse for 2011.

Top Der Da moved straight up to Open Elementary Level in late 2011 at the State Equestrian Centre Dressage Challenge and was placed 2nd. During 2012 Top Der Da continued to compete at Open Elementary Level with his lowest placing being 4th. His final show for the season was a win at the Perth Dressage Day at the State Equestrian Centre.

With Top Der Da's competition success at Elementary Level, his scores and placings were submitted to the Westfalen Registry in Germany. Top Der Da was granted full Licensing for Westphalia, Germany through his success in sport which is the equivalent to a stallion completing the 30 day test.

More success for Top der Da came in the 2013 season. He is a true showman and always tries his best at competition. At the DAWA Championship Dressage Day in May 2013 he placed 2nd in the Open Competition once again and was close behind the winner.

Top Der Da has fantastic rideability and is extremely willing in his training. In 2014 he started his campaign at Medium Level and placed well in open classes. At the 2014 WA State Dressage Championships Top Der Da placed 5th at medium level in a strong field of seasoned horses. To top off the year he qualified to compete Medium level at the Masters Series, a competition for the top horses at each level and placed 5th.

In 2015 Top Der Da placed 3rd in the Master Series Final at Advanced level.

He continued his competition success in 2015 at Advanced with the highlight of the year being a win at the masters of Dressage Competition with International FEI 5* guest judge, Stephen Clarke. We were very honoured to be judged by someone of this caliber who judges at World Cup and Olympic events.

At the end of 2015 Top Der Da competed in his first Prix St Georges test, winning first place at 9 years of age.

Now in 2016, he will continue to compete in the small tour levels.

His piaffe and lateral work have developed well and he is a fantastic horse with a really exciting future in dressage. This stallion has amazing power in the hind-quarters and excellent hocks and is passing this power through to his foals.

Top Der Da is proving to be a good option to downsize as well as modernize taller warmblood mares as well as upgrading the movement and power for smaller pony mares. Despite the fact that Top Der Da is over pony height, his pedigree shows smaller genetics behind him.

His first foal crops in Germany are now under saddle and are already having success with wins and places in dressage and jumping. The most exciting reports are that his progeny have excellent rideability and are easily ridden by small children in Europe. His Australian progeny are also now coming under saddle with great rideability and movement and are starting to gain success in the pony dressage arena showing exceptional rideability and movement.

Trussardi's sire is the very successful dressage pony sire **Timberland** who was a triple Bundeschampionate finalist. Timberland has numerous wins and placings up to Medium level dressage. He is known for his excellent rideability, his elegance and his fantastic movement. These traits have been inherited by Trussardi himself.

Timberland is now becoming well known for his highly successful progeny in Germany. In 2004 his son Trentino was awarded Reserve Champion of his licensing and later was also a Bundeschampionate finalist. In 2006 he also had two sons Trocadero and Tivio licensed. Tivio was sold at the Westphalian Elite Auction in 2009 for the highest price. Timberland's gelding son Tesio was also the highest price pony sold at the Westphalian Elite Auction in 2010.

Trussardi's full sister Tammy Wynette was awarded Reserve Champion in Handorf 2005 and was awarded the Silver medal at the 2007 Bundeschampionate.

Trussardi's dam is **Disco Lady** by Dschingis Khan, a stallion imported to Germany and who shaped the breeding of Westphalian ponies.

Disco Lady's bloodlines also boast the Welsh line of Downland Fleet Foot (Sir) who had eight licensed sons including the famous stallion Shalom who was the grandfather of St. Pr Nadine, who is the dam of the multi-champion sire, Dressman 1.

Trussardi was awarded the title of Premium stallion at his licensing for Westphalia in 2009 which is the highest title that the judges can award a stallion, clearly a super start to Trussardi's career. He was also awarded a Premium Class II title at the Weser-Ems licensing, also the highest title awarded by this registry.

Trussardi was described in Germany as a genius of movement! He combines this movement with an extreme willingness to perform and this is shown with his outstanding competition record.

At his first competition start as a three year old he dominated the entire field at Westerkappeln with a total score of 85.83 %. His second competition start at Milte Sassenberg in a strong field resulted in a second victory. Trussardi had the highest score for the day with 87.5% including three scores of 8.5 and three scores of 9. This was an amazing start to Trussardi's career under saddle, which is a great tribute to his strength of character and his brilliant rideability. These two starts earned him a qualification for the Bundeschampionate 2010. Once again showed his excellent character and stayed relaxed in the excitement of this huge national event being awarded the Bronze Medal for the 3 year old German Riding Pony stallions.

Trussardi competed at the Federal Stallion Show in January 2011 in Berlin, an event where 50 of the best German Riding Pony Stallions aged between 4 and 12 yo are selected to compete based on performance. He was awarded 2nd Reserve Champion in the GRP breed section, Reserve Champion in the Jumping competition, 2nd Reserve Champion of the Dressage competition and Reserve Champion of the Versatility class. Trussardi was the best performed four year old stallion in all of the categories.

In March 2011, a free jumping competition was held in Bad- Salzuflen for four year old ponies with Trussardi placing 3rd in this competition with a score of 8. Going from strength to strength, in May 2011 amongst a very strong field at the Olfen-Vinum Young Horse Show, Trussardi was the winner with an overall score of 8.42, the highest score over all the dressage classes. He scored a 9 for his trot and a 9.5 for conformation. At Trussardi's second start in 2011 he placed 2nd in a strong field in a young horse class scoring 8.5.



Trussardi showed his reliable top class form in a competition at Westfalen Woche where he was also the winner of his Westfalen Bundeschampionate Qualifier scoring an impressive overall score of 8.58. Trussardi dominated the entire 4 year old field of ponies gaining himself a score of 8.55 and was awarded the Westfalen Champion of 2011 for all four year old ponies.

Trussardi competed at the 2011 Bundeschampionate and was awarded the Bronze Medal for 4 yo German Riding Pony stallions.

Trussardi loves his life in Australia, truly an old soul with a bold character.

Trussardi was a star at our first Dynamik Stallions Open Day in 2012 and he very much enjoyed the fact that we had 200 spectators gathered to watch him strut his stuff to music both in hand and under saddle.

Trussardi went to his first Australian Dressage competition in late 2012 at the beautiful Brookleigh Estate and gained a 2nd place. Since then, Trussardi has proven himself again and again as the reliable performer he has always been and is continuing to place against warmbloods in Open Preliminary and Novice Level in 2013. He placed 6th in a strong field of the 2013 State Dressage Championships.

In 2014 Trussardi completed his licensing for Westphalia in Germany via a short test made possible by the Australian Continental Equestrian Group. This involved an in hand presentation, ridden assessment under saddle, a ridden assessment by a test rider, free running, free jumping and jumping under saddle. Trussardi was awarded the highest title of Elite for the ACE Group and is now a fully licensed stallion for Westphalia. He was Reserve Champion Licensed Stallion for the entire Australian ACE Tour of 2014 behind Golden Rock out of all warmbloods and ponies assessed for the ACE group.

Trussardi placed in all open classes at Elementary level in 2014 but unfortunately missed the WA State Championships due to a minor injury.

Trussardi had a very successful 2015, starting off with jumping competitions with clear rounds and making clear jump off rounds in 90 cm classes. He then continued with wins and places at Medium and Advanced level in open fields against Warmbloods.

It was a great honour to finish the 2015 season with an invitation to the Masters of Dressage Masterclass presented by the FEI 5* international judge **Stephen Clarke** and alongside **Australia's top FEI Rider, Brett Parberry**. Trussardi loved being in front of a crowd as always.

After such a great year, Trussardi was invited to be on the WA State Dressage Development Squad for 2016. He will continue to compete at Medium and Advanced levels in 2016 and will start training towards Prix St Geroges.

He has the most amazing front and neck and is an uncomplicated ride with the bonus of outstanding paces for dressage. Trussardi has put some exceptional quality foals on the ground in Germany with one of his foals awarded the Silver Medal at a foal show which allowed the dam to complete her State Premium Title. He also has a son in Germany who was licensed in 2014 and other progeny now under saddle are reported to have top characters, easy to ride and powerful paces.

With numerous progeny now in Australia, we are thrilled that he is improving and creating a super uphill front for his foals as well as passing on his laid back, easy loving character. He can help to add power to the foals and create a longer elegant leg.

He is the perfect match with mares that may be a bit sensitive and hot as he tends to level out the character of the foals.

You cannot go wrong with Trussardi progeny who really show their true talent once they go under saddle.

Golden Rock's sire is **HET Golden Dream** who is a Premium stallion in Westphalia and despite his size of barely 14hh he later won his stallion performance test and the NRW stallion championships of 2005. He scored a fantastic score of 8.63 in his 30 day stallion performance test. In the same year he won eight young horse classes including three against warmbloods. He has had wins in dressage classes up to elementary level.

Golden Rocks dam is State Premium Mare **Beauty Queen** whose grandsire Blackboy is one of the most influential foundation sires for dressage ponies in Germany.

Beauty Queen won a lot of Elite Mare shows in Germany. One of her most famous sons is the licensed son CGN Crocodile Rock who was the 3 year old Bundeschampion of dressage ponies in 2006 and was sold at the Westphalian Elite Auction for 110,000 euros in 2008.

A daughter of Beauty Queen, Lea by Leon was awarded a state premium title. Another daughter Catlyn placed 4th in the Bundeschampionate finals in 2009 and 3rd place in the finals of the 2010 Bundeschampionate Finals with Henrike Sommer.

Beauty Queen's grand dam SPS Silvertop is the dam of five licensed sons herself. Now of course, the amazing mare St.Pr.St Beauty Queen has another premium licensed son with our very own Golden Rock.

Dynamik Stallions purchased Golden Rock at the Elite Pony Sales in Germany in 2008 at 4 months old. He started his competition career in Germany with Danica Duen.

Golden Rock was presented at the licensing at Verden for Hannover registry in 2010, winning 2nd Reserve Champion as well as being awarded a Premium title which is the highest title that can be awarded by the judges. He was described as an excellent pony type at his licensing with brilliant movement and was awarded a 9 for his loose uphill trot. He won the hearts of everyone with his natural charm.

Golden Rock was presented at the Westphalian Licensing and was awarded a Premium title once again. He was also the Reserve Champion Westphalian Stallion of 2011 out of 83 ponies that qualified for the licensing.

At the licensing for Weser-Ems he was awarded the title of Premium Class II, the highest title that can be awarded at this registry.

He commenced his stud duties in February 2011 in Germany to top quality mares. The resulting foals were super quality and many of these foals had wins at foal shows around Germany. Despite the fact that this was a big ask for our 3 year old, he ended in the top eight in the finals and we were extremely pleased with result at this prestigious **National event. He scored 9's for his canter in both rounds and also 9's for his type.** The judges commented that he was a top class stallion with excellent musculature and quality movement.

Golden Rock is enjoying life in Australia and loves to go out in the paddock every day. In 2012 he was presented at a Dressage Judges Taskforce Seminar Young Horse Clinic at the State Equestrian Centre doing a great job and showing his super paces and excellent rideability. He was also presented at the Dynamik Stallions Open Day in 2012 in front of a crowd of 200 people attending and he did a fantastic job under saddle and showed himself off superbly.

Golden Rock had a break from competition whilst he was maturing in his body and we focused on his training at home as well as continuing with his breeding duties.

In 2014 Golden Rock completed his licensing for Westphalia in Germany via a short test made possible by the Australian Continental Equestrian Group. This involved an in hand presentation, ridden assessment under saddle, a ridden assessment by a test rider, free running, free jumping and jumping under saddle. Golden Rock was awarded the highest title of Elite for the ACE group and is now a fully licensed stallion for Westphalia. He was also awarded the Champion Licensed Stallion for the entire Australian ACE tour of 2014.

At the Autumn Dressage Festival in 2014 he was highly successful in gaining 4th place in the overall Preliminary Championships in strong fields that included imported warmbloods. He also competed in the 6 yo Young Horse class the following day with more quality warmbloods and was awarded Reserve Champion. He was awarded many wins and places in Western Australia for 2014 in Open Dressage.

He was awarded State Novice Dressage Champion in 2014 and gained a 3rd place at Elementary level at the WA State Dressage Championships. He was also awarded the Uwe Spelen Award for Reserve Champion Dressage Horse of the Year 2014 for WA, sponsored by Hermitage Dressage. He had a fantastic season and it was a great honour to receive such an award.

Golden Rock was presented in hand and under saddle at the 2014 Dynamik Stallions Open Day and really impressed the crowds.

In 2015 Golden Rock competed in jumping competitions with clear rounds to not only show his versatility but also his amazing jumping technique.

For the 2016 competition season Golden Rock will return to the dressage arena and will be competing at Medium level.

Golden Rock is a truly talented stallion with very athletic and expressive paces. He has super knee action and an active hind leg. He is already showing that he has super piaffe and expressive flying changes. We have no doubt that he has the talent to make FEI dressage.

He is a proven top breeding stallion over pony mares and has also now proven himself to be a great sire over warmblood mares with the resulting quality progeny. He has several sons in Europe that are now licensed from his first crop of foals as well as some state premium daughters in Germany. Ponies from his first crop are now starting under saddle with excellent reports of their rideability and movement.

A gelding and stallion by Golden Rock were finalists at the 2015 Bundeschampionate.

His foals in Australia have gain Elite and Premium titles in foal assessments and we are very happy that he stamps his foals with great swing in the back and fabulous paces. His Australian progeny are also winners at breed shows and his first crop of Australian foals are now starting under saddle with super movement and exceptional temperaments.
